The theme of the conference is "**The Castle Walls are Gone.**" This theme allows a focus on the expanding/disappearing perimeter, cloud computing, Web 2.0, Internet risks, etc. We will have two keynote speakers, one at breakfast, and one at lunch.

We will have two breakout tracks during the conference; Technical and Business/Compliance.

Technical Track (1) – Focuses on the detailed means of managing the various components of information security, and ways to incorporate these methods into real-world environments.

Business/Compliance(2) – Focuses on how managing information security is important to and can have significant impact on the business environment. Also focuses on why, how and when security management may be required by regulating entities, necessary for annual reporting, or desired for business best practices. It also deals with the related risks inherent in those situations.

Demonstrations – We also plan to have some exciting & informative demos throughout the day, on useful tools and software, or other related products & services.

Each presentation must be related, in general, to our conference theme & the specific track in which it is presented.

The conference presentations are **vendor-neutral**. Any presentation that focuses on product rather than technology or process, will be disallowed. We require you to provide a copy of your presentation prior to the conference. All session speakers are on a volunteer basis.
